The RHS Level 2 Certificate in Practical Horticulture is usually particularly competitive, so it is essential you provide details of your gardening experience.

For the RHS Level 3 applicants, and those wishing to take the Winterbourne Certificate in Garden Design, you will need to show knowledge or experience equivalent to level 2 studies.





Your application will be processed at the earliest opportunity by the Learning Officer but may take several weeks to process. Once your application form has been received and accepted, a place will be offered. A deposit will be required to accept your place offer.
