RHS Level 2 Certificate in the Principles of Plant Growth and Development

Costs: The cost of this course is £1250 including initial assessment costs. There is a breakdown of deposit details available at the end of this document.

Lessons: 32 Thursdays from mid September 2024, running 10am-3.15pm (includes 45 min lunch).

Course summary

This theory course is intended for those for those that wish to work in professional horticulture or would like to increase their personal horticultural skills.

The course provides learners with a solid theoretical grounding and understanding of the science of plants – looking at how they function, nutrition and health adaptations. Learners will also develop an understanding of a variety of roles in the horticultural industry.

Course content

The qualification consists of eight topics split into two units. The units cover underpinning knowledge of the following topics:

UNIT 1

- Plant Science 1 plant structure and function
- Plant Health factors affecting plant health
- Plant Nutrition plant nutrition and growing media
- Plant Specification matching plant needs and site requirements

UNIT 2

- Plant Science 2 range and role of plant adaptations
- Planting Styles range of horticultural plantings
- Horticulture and Society social, environmental, and economic contribution
- Biodiversity applied knowledge of habitats encouraging biodiversity





Assessment

Assessment is by written examination through two in person exams that cover the content of the units being studied. Each exam is 120 minutes long. Examinations will be sat in February and in June. Examination fees are included in the cost of the course but further costs will be incurred if resits are needed.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements needed to study the RHS Level 2 Certificate in the Principles of Horticulture. A good standard of written English is required to successfully sit the examinations.

Progression

You could progress on to other Level 2 certificates in horticulture; for example the RHS Level 2 Certificate in Practical Horticulture; or on to Level 3 study.

Please note, successful completion of both Certificates at Level 2 entitles you to achieve the RHS Level 2 Certificate in the Principles and Practices of Horticulture.

This course will take place on 32 Thursdays September 2023 to June 2024. Lessons take place from 10am – 3.15pm and include a 45 minute lunch break.
